




Answer the questions below about the number of stickers four students received from their teacher.

Answer the questions below about the number of stickers four students received from their teacher.


- 1. How many stickers did Wendi receive? 4 + 4 + 2 = 10 stickers
- 2. How many more stickers did Dani receive than Jon? 12 6 = 6 stickers
- 3. How many total stickers did Jon, Wendi, and Ben receive? 6 + 10 + 4 = 20 stickers
- 4. How many more stickers did Dani and Jon receive together than Wendi?

$$18 - 10 = 8$$

5. How many more stickers did Dani receive than Ben and Jon together?

$$12 - (4 + 6) = 12 - 10 = 2$$

Answer the questions below about the number of beads four students used in art club.

- 6. How many total beads did Sofia and Amber use? 20 + 35 = 55 beads
- 7. How many more beads did Nichole use than Laurie? 40 25 = 15 beads
- 8. How many more beads did Amber, Nichole, and Laurie use than Sofia used?

$$(35 + 40 + 25) - 20 = 100 - 20 = 80$$

- 9. How many total beads did Nichole and Sofia use together? 40 + 20 = 60 beads
- 10. How many total beads did all four students use altogether? 25 + 40 + 20 + 35 = 120 beads
