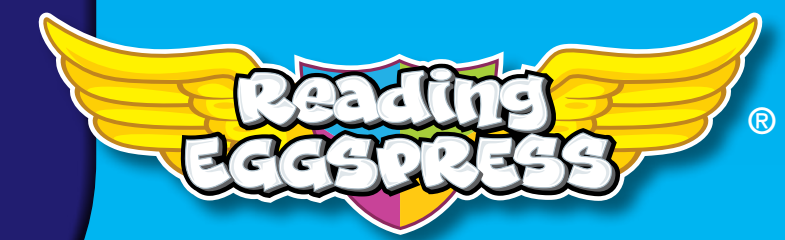


# Comprehension strategies



## Before Reading

### Predictions

What do you think the book will be about?  
Use clues to support your predictions.

## During Reading

### Text-to-self connection

When have you felt like the character?  
Would you act in the same way?

### Text-to-text connection

Does this book make you think of  
another book you have read?

### Text-to-world connection

Does this story remind you of a  
historical event?

## After Reading

### Retelling

Can you retell the story using key  
details?

### Summarizing

Why are you reading this text?  
What message was the author trying  
to send?

### Sequencing

Can you order the events? Use time  
words like first, then, next and finally.

What is the story mostly about?

Where does the story take place?

Who are the main characters?

When does the story take place?

What happened at the beginning, middle, and end?
