## Maintain Authorized Course Status

You should work proactively with schools that offer this course to ensure they add the course and your organization to their official record of AP course offerings for the 2023 - 2024 academic year in the AP Course Audit. Courses not selected by an accredited secondary school or homeschool will be turned off and teachers will lose access to AP Classroom after January 31.

## AP Course Ledger

The AP Course Ledger serves as an official record of appropriately accredited secondary schools and/or those sanctioned by their state education agency that are authorized to use the AP designation on student transcripts, in course catalogs, and on school websites.

For accredited organizations, as defined by their recognized ability to issue school transcripts and diplomas, eligible AP courses will be listed on the AP Course Ledger under that organization's respective name. For non-accredited organizations, eligible AP courses will need to be selected by an accredited secondary school from their AP Course Audit account to be listed in the AP Course Ledger along with your organization's name.
